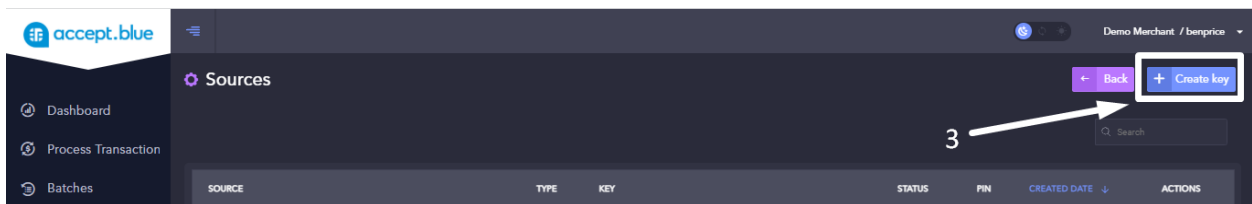
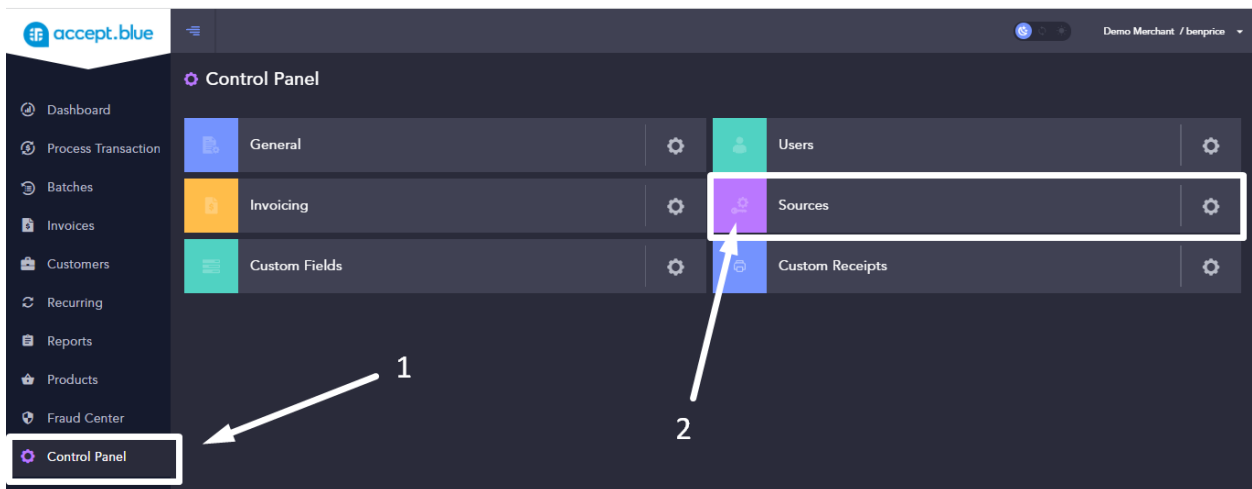


accept.blue gateway + Magento 2 plugin

Setup Guide

1) Contact support@accept.blue requesting access to download and install the plugin.

2) Once installed, navigate to *Control Panel* in the virtual terminal > *Sources* > *Create new Key*.



3) Select API, enter a Name, a PIN (password), check off all credit card commands and desired card types and click Save.

4) Create another source key as detailed in step 2), but this time select Tokenization key from the dropdown. Enter a name and click Save.

5) Login to your Magento 2 Admin portal. Navigate to *Stores > Configuration > Sales > Payment Methods*.

6) Configure your plugin by:

- Selecting Yes for Vault Enabled (this allows customers to save payment methods for future use).
- Entering the title you want customers to see at checkout.
- Entering the API source key generated by the gateway.
- Entering the API PIN you created.
- Entering the Tokenization source key generated by the gateway.
- Selecting Yes for Sandbox mode if this is for testing purposes, or No if this is being configured for a production account.
- Make sure you click on *Save Configuration* when done.
